

Trumpet Honeysuckle



Lonicera sempervirens

A fabulous native vine that blooms profusely in waves from late spring, all summer, and into fall. An absolute magnet for hummingbirds! Twining climber that needs support. Not aggressive or difficult to control, but will grow as tall and wide as you allow it. Full to light shade. Average to moist soil. Aphids can be a cosmetic nuisance, but don't seem to weaken the plant or affect blooming.



Deer do browse this plant so if you have heavy deer pressure, you should protect it when it is young. A well established plant will rarely be bothered by them.
