Blue Vervain



Verbena hastata

Long blooming wildflower, pollinator superfood, and powerful medicinal herb



Blue Vervain enjoys wet areas and does great in rain gardens or average soils. Grows to 3 to 4 feet tall, but it's slight form allows it to be planted thickly, or amongst other perennials. The candelabra like form and intense blue blooms have a wonderful effect that is best enjoyed in masses. Reseeds liberally. Great with Cardinal Flower, Helen's flower, Joe Pye, Boneset.



Hoary Vervain (Verbena stricta) has all the benefits and good looks of Blue Vervain, but prefers average to dry sites. Grows 2-3 feet tall, very narrow, and the tiny blooms are a soft purple. Looks great with Purple Lovegrass, Coreopsis Moonbeam, Prairie Dropseed, and Sweet Goldenrod.
