Canada Anemone



Anemone canadensis

A vigorous native groundcover. Leaves are beautifully cut and textured and provide a long season of interest. Clean white flowers are borne atop lax stems and provide great movement above the sea of foliage. Seed heads provide more interest after blooms fade.

Deer resistant. Clay tolerant.

Foliage to 12-15 inches tall, flowers to 18" tall. Foliage is not evergreen but does emerge early in spring.

Most aggressive in moist to wet sites in full sun to part shade, but will grow as a slowly spreading specimen in average sites with part sun.



In its ideal situation, Canada Anemone is very aggressive and will swallow up less vigorous perennials. Bracken Fern makes an excellent companion and will grow right amongst even a thick patch. Planting under shrubs like fothergilla, hydrangea, and ninebark is also a great plan.
