

Foxglove Beardtongue

Penstemon digitalis



Hummingbirds, bees, and butterflies love the tubular flowers of this sweet native perennial.

Blooms late spring. Flowers are held high above the bulk of the foliage, making this a great plant for the front third of the border. Plants have a narrow footprint and are great to work into rock gardens, just off the edges of pathways, and containers. Ours are seed grown and will have subtle variations in the foliage and flower colors.

To 3 feet tall. Sun to part shade. Clay adapted. Very drought tolerant once established.
