

Hyssop Leaved Boneset

Eupatorium hyssopifolium



A fine textured vase shaped native perennial with narrow, gray green foliage. In late summer and early fall plants are covered with wide, soft clouds of white florets that attract a myriad of pollinators. The blossoms mature into soft buff colored seed clusters that mingle nicely with autumn grasses and other seed heads.

Deer resistant. Clay tolerant.

Thrives in well drained or dry sites with sun to part sun. Grows 3-4 feet tall and wide.



Hyssop leaved Boneset looks great with False Indigo, New England Aster, Switchgrass, any of the Echinaceas, Henry Eilers Rudbeckia, and Black Eyed Susan.
