

Showy Goldenrod

Solidago speciosa



Spectacular native wildflower with excellent wildlife value

Blooms mid to late summer.

Grows 4-5 feet tall, 2-3 feet wide.

Not an aggressive spreader.

Goldenrods attract native specialist bees, and are a superfood for native pollinators, providing essential amino acids that other plants, especially exotic ones, do not provide. They are an incredibly important source of quality food late in the season

Goldenrods are hosts to over 100 species of butterflies and moths, as well as providing seed for birds.

Deer resistant, drought tolerant, and tough.

Sun to partial sun. Clay tolerant.

Looks great with Indian Grass, Switchgrass, native asters, Black Eyed Susan, Ironweed, Foxglove Beardtongue.
